Stable Commutator Length in Baumslag-Solitar groups

Abstract: I will talk about computing stable commutator length in Baumslag-Solitar groups and about the spectrum of values it takes. For a certain elements, stable commutator length is computable and takes only rational values. There is a gap in the stable commutator length spectrum: no element of a Baumslag-Solitar group has stable commutator length between 0 and 1/12. Some of these techniques apply more generally to other groups acting on trees. This is joint work with Max Forester and Joel Louwsma. Video
